SPUR offers Badge Programs for Girl Scouts of all levels. We offer a variety of thoughtful and engaging workshops designed to provide interactive opportunities to engage with peers and fulfill the required curriculum for each badge listed. *We do not provide badges as part of our workshop programs.*

Daisy

Good Neighbor Badge (90 mins, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

Make a 3D map of your community, neighborhood and school. What does it mean to be a good neighbor and how can you become a good citizen at school? By using different mapping methods, we will explore our state, town and neighborhood to earn this badge!

Eco Learner Badge (90 mins, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

Leave no Trace and be prepared to protect nature before you go outdoors! Create a sculpture using debris found in parks and beaches to help teach others about the importance of reducing trash and caring for the natural world. Join our Go Green Clean Up and make the world a better place!

Brownie

Philanthropist Badge (90 mins, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

What is a Philanthropist? How are we all the same? How are we all different? Learn about needs versus wants by talking with SPUR leaders who serve our community in different ways. Become a troop of Philanthropists by the end of the program by assembling personal care kits or harvesting produce for donation.

Eco Friends Badge (90 mins, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

Become a steward of our oceans by learning how currents move trash around the world and study the effects of plastic debris left in the environment. Clean up the beach and create a sculpture using debris found in parks and beaches.

My Family Story Badge (90 mins, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

Create a Map of My Heart and discover how your family evolved to include you! Discover where your family is from and paint a family story map. Share your story with your troop and compare similarities and differences.

Celebrating Community Badge (90 mins, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

Make a 3D map of your community, neighborhood and school while identifying community symbols. Forge your own troop tour around your community and march in a parade!

Making Friends Badge (90 mins, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

Know your troop members better by sharing favorite activities, singing songs and practicing friendship. Demonstrate kindness by using kind words and filling our buckets and finally create beautiful flowers for friends new and old.

Junior

Gardener Badge (3 meetings, 1 hour/meeting, \$15/scout, 5 scout minimum)

Earn this badge in the SPUR Community Roots Garden in 3 meetings. Meeting #1 tours the garden, discusses garden design and hardiness zones. Meeting #2 scouts will plant seeds and seedlings to watch them grow! Meeting #3 will teach scouts how to harvest veggies and donate them to the Marblehead Food Pantry.

Animal Habitats Badge (2 hours, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

What do wild animals need to survive? How does human activity impact those needs? Explore different animal habitats while protecting them on a habitat clean up. Create an animal house from the debris found on your clean up.

Flowers Badge (2 hours, \$10/scout, 5 scout minimum)

How do flowers help us communicate? Learn all the secrets of flowers from aromatherapy to the many meanings of different blooms. Once you've decoded the botany behind each stem, scouts will create flower art and arrangements for donation to a local community program in need.
